
# What will you be doing on Sunday 5th July?

Did you know that a nationwide clap to thank the NHS will take place on Sunday 5th July, in what is intended to become an annual tradition? People will be encouraged to applaud the heroes of the present coronavirus pandemic with their family and friends at 5:00pm, on what will be the 72nd anniversary of the NHS.

At the peak of the pandemic, many people became involved in the Clap for Carers tradition which was the brainchild of Annemarie Plas; and lasted for 10 weeks. It was in recognition of all the hard work and dedication shown by doctors and nurses as they cared for all the sick and the dying in our hospitals; and was extended to include all of our essential key workers.

The NHS is an amazing organisation and came into being on 5th July 1948. It was the first completely free healthcare system anywhere in the world; and was made available to all British citizens. It brought doctors, nurses and dentists together under one service; but a lot has changed in the 72 years since it began. Nowadays it employs 1.7 million people and is the fifth largest employer in the world!

It is mostly funded through the taxes paid by the people who work; and through National Insurance contributions. A smaller amount of the money comes from prescriptions charges and the charges for dental work.



God chose Saul to be the King of Israel, but Saul chose to disobey Him. God said that the next king would not be saul's son.


Saul didn't know that God had chosen David to be the next king.

David waited until Saul was far enough away then he shouted to him.




Your majesty, I could have killed you today, but 1 knew it was wrong. I want to prove to you I'm not trying to harm you.




