The Sound of Worship

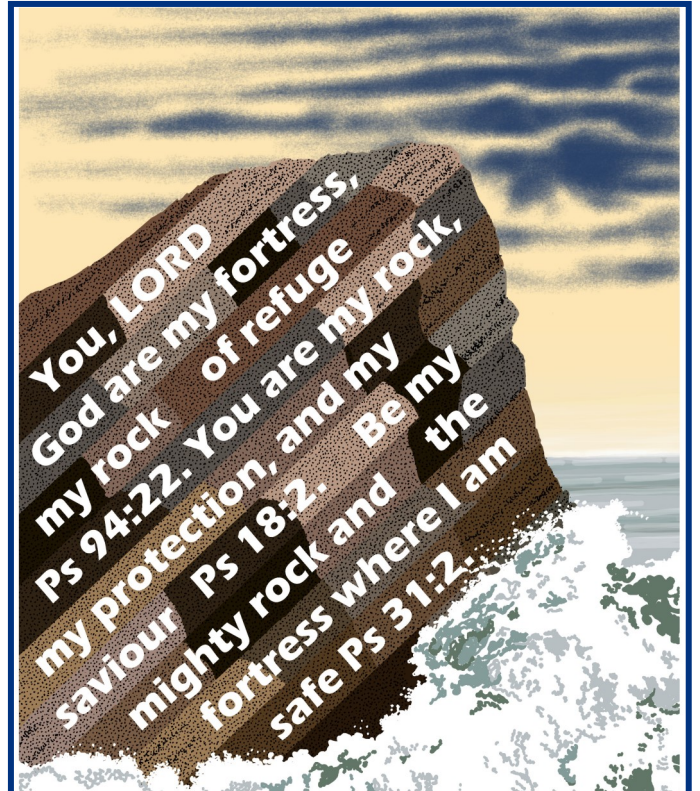
As we gather for the service

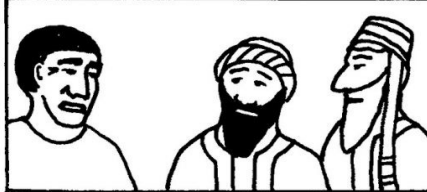
Bible Bite

But he says he understands authority and knows you have it. You only have to say so and his servant will be healed

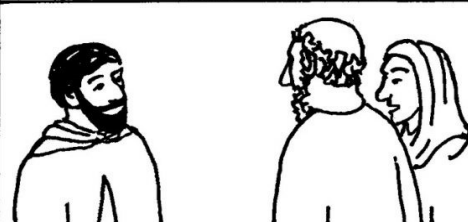


Jesus was amazed!

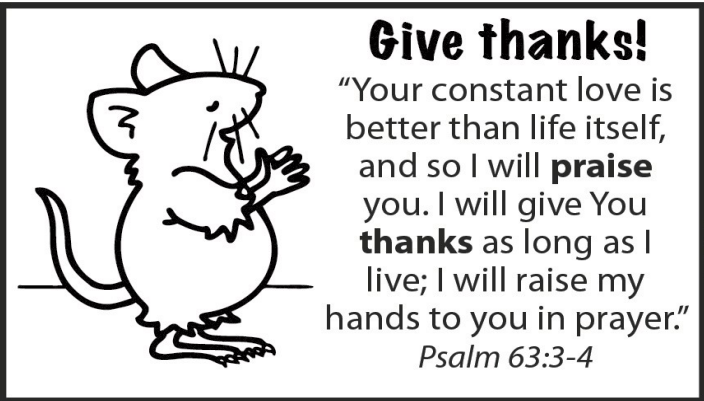
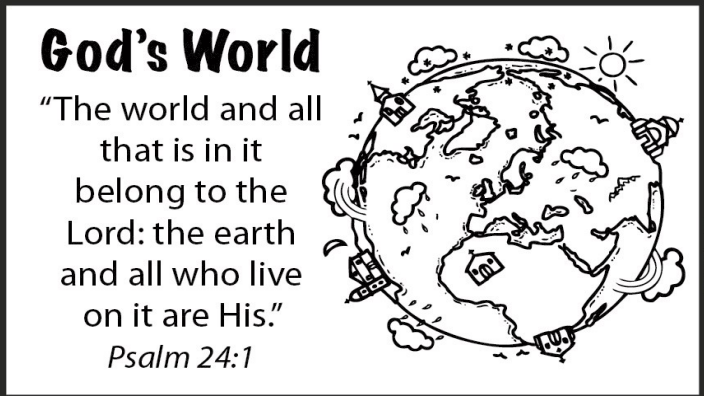
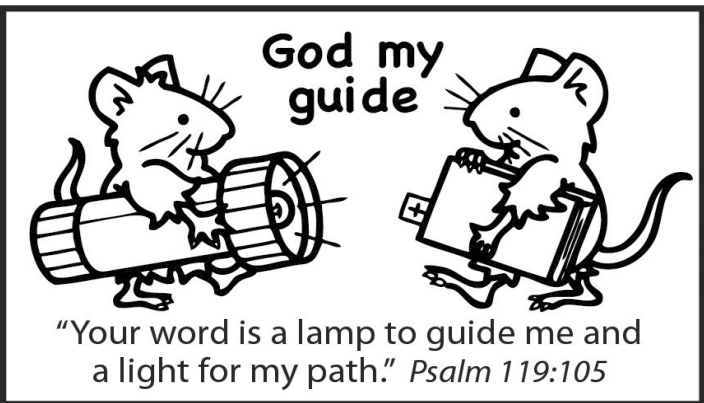




The **PSALMS** are hymns of **PRAYER** and **PRAISE** to God.
